- Occasional "Special Event" webinars may be scheduled with guest speakers – in Summer as well as Fall

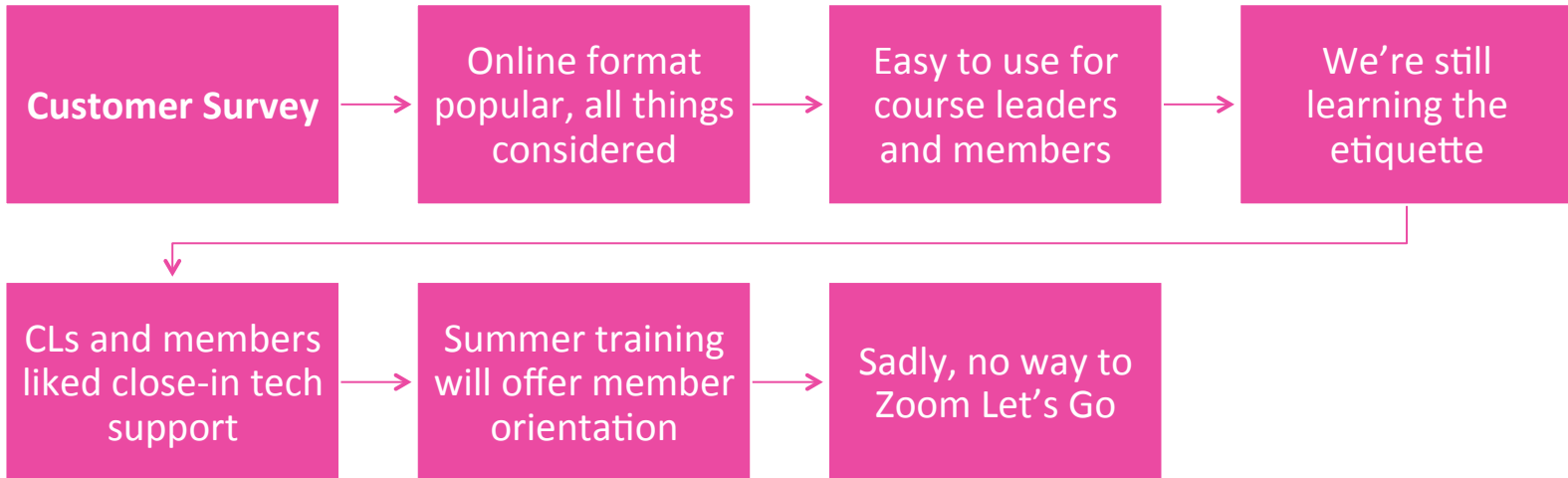
